Octavio Oliveira is an economist specializing in air transport policy and competition regulation. he holds a master's degree in sustainable air transport management, along with postgraduate qualifications in aviation law, public regulation and competition, and financial management.

Since 2021, he has been serving as a competition regulation specialist at the african civil aviation commission, where he plays a key role in monitoring and addressing anti-competitive practices and supporting the implementation of the single african air transport market (SAATM).

Prior to joining AFCAC, octavio built extensive experience in cabo verde across both public and private sectors. he worked with the national airline, the ministry of transport and infrastructure, and the national multisectoral regulator overseeing energy, water, communications, and transport. he also served as commercial and marketing director in a real estate and investment firm.

Over a 20-year career in civil aviation, he spent 13 years at the national civil aviation authority, including seven years as deputy director general for economic regulation and air transport, contributing to the development of regulatory frameworks and market oversight.
