Brenda Ntihinyurwa is a Ugandan lawyer and international air law specialist with over 15 years of experience in regional integration, treaty law, and civil aviation regulatory harmonisation. As Senior Legal Officer at the East African Community Civil Aviation Safety and Security Oversight Agency (EAC-CASSOA), she provides strategic legal leadership on aviation safety, security, air transport liberalisation, and the implementation of ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices across EAC Partner States.

Her work focuses on developing regional aviation legislation, supporting SAATM and Yamoussoukro Decision implementation, advising high-level policy organs, and strengthening Africa's aviation governance frameworks. Brenda previously served as a Legal Expert at the East African Community Secretariat, where she contributed to regional trade, infrastructure, and legal integration initiatives. She also currently serves as an Administrative Council Member of the YD Dispute Settlement Mechanism.

She holds an LL.M in International Trade Law from the University of Cape Town, a Post-graduate Diploma in Legal Practice from the Law Development Centre – Uganda, International Air Law Certificate from ICAO; and is currently enrolled in a Master of International Air Law programme at ITAérea Aeronautical Business School, Spain. She is an Advocate of the High Court of Uganda and a member of several professional legal bodies.

Brenda continues to contribute to Africa's aviation transformation through legal expertise, policy development, and institutional strengthening.
